
Terms of Reference

Inspection and Enforcement Committee

1. To advise the Council on the development of policy in all matters relating to inspection and enforcement and to keep abreast of international developments in the area of inspection and enforcement.
2. On the advice of the Registrar to warrant and appoint an Authorised Officer for all purposes of the Pharmacy Act 2007.
3. To contribute to the development of the annual Service Plan and monitor performance and investigate variances against budget on a quarterly basis for the Inspection and Enforcement Unit.
4. To report to Council on a regular basis on the actions of the Inspection and Enforcement Committee through the Chairperson.
5. To liaise with other Committees of Council as required.
6. To consider and review risks and the mitigating measures to be taken.
7. To review the Terms of Reference of the Committee on an annual basis and make such recommendations to Council as are deemed appropriate.
8. In accordance with Rule 24(3) of the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland (Council) Regulations 2008, the Council hereby dispenses with the necessity to confirm acts of the Inspection and Enforcement Committee provided they are undertaken within its stated terms of reference set out above.
