



IN THE MATTER OF PART 6 OF THE PHARMACY ACT 2007

Mr Neil Sokay MPSI (Reg. No. 7388)

Following the submission of a report of the Professional Conduct Committee (the “**Committee**”), the Council, at its meeting on 18 June 2020, decided to attach conditions to the registration of Mr. Neil Sokay MPSI as a pharmacist.

The conditions, as set out below, have expired. However, in accordance with the PSI’s Publications & Disclosure Policy 2022, public notice of the conditions which attached to the registration of a pharmacist or pharmacy following fitness to practise proceedings shall remain on the website for a period of 2 years following the expiry of those conditions.

Conditions formerly attached to Mr Sokay’s registration as a pharmacist are as follows:

- (i) Mr Sokay shall engage with a suitably qualified pharmacist nominated by the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland (“the **PSI**”) to carry out three audits of his practice, with particular reference to the findings of poor professional performance referred to above and to report to the PSI;
- (ii) The first such audit shall be completed within three months of this condition coming into effect;
- (iii) The second and third audits shall be completed at six-monthly intervals thereafter; and
- (iv) Mr Sokay shall discharge all costs associated with the implementation of, and his compliance with, these conditions.
